In 2021 she became a member of the **SDG Thought Leaders Circle** and was invited to become **UK Country Lead on Collective Stewardship for the G100**. She also joined the **Harvard Flourishing Program's Educational Futures and Spirituality working groups**.

In 2022 she joined the **Inner Development Goals (IDGs) Catalyst Network** and also became an advisor to the **Quantic Humanism/Flourishing AI Project**. She currently works with a number of other projects worldwide that are committed to a more regenerative, collaborative and co-creative future.
